10 **TO APPROPRIATE SEVEN HUNDRED AND FORTY DOLLARS (\$740.00) TO THE**
11 **ALTERNATIVE SERVICE BREAK CLUB AT LSU (ASB) TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF A**
12 **SERVICE TRIP TO PANAMA CITY, FLORIDA FROM MARCH 16 TO MARCH 21, 2008.**

14 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, ASB IS A RECOGNIZED STUDENT ORGANIZATION AT
15 LSU, AND;

16 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, TWO VEHICLES WILL BE DRIVEN TO PANAMA CITY,
17 FLORIDA TO ACCOMMODATE STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN ASB'S
18 2008 ALTERNATIVE SERVICE BREAK EVENT, AND;

19 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THESE TWO VEHICLES WILL EACH TRAVEL EIGHT
20 HUNDRED AND FORTY (840) MILES ROUND TRIP, AND;

21 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE STUDENT SENATE BYLAWS ALLOW FOR THE
22 REIMBURSEMENT OF TRAVEL EXPENSES AT THE RATE SET BY THE
23 STATE OF LOUISIANA, AND;

24 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, THE STATE MILEAGE RATE IS FORTY-FOUR (44) CENTS
25 PER MILE, AND;

26 **PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, THROUGH ASB EVENTS, STUDENTS ARE GIVEN THE
27 OPPORTUNITY TO SPEND THEIR SPRING BREAK VACATION IN A
28 PRODUCTIVE, SERVICE-ORIENTED MANNER, AND;

30 **PARAGRAPH 7:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT
31 GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY
32 AND AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE
33 THUS DOES HEREBY APPROPRIATE SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY
34 DOLLARS (\$740.00) TO BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE ALTERNATIVE
35 SERVICE BREAK CLUB AT LSU TO PARTIALLY COVER THE COSTS
36 OF TRAVEL FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING THIS EVENT;

38 **PARAGRAPH 8:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A THREE-
39 FOURTHS (3/4) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND
40 SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR
41 PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND
42 SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF
43 SUCH APPROVAL.

45 **PARAGRAPH 9:** ALL MONIES NOT EXPENDED BY THE END OF THE 2008 SPRING
46 ACADEMIC SEMESTER WILL REVERT TO THE SENATE GENERAL
47 CONTINGENCY. SHOULD ANY PROVISION OF ARTICLE VI
48 SECTIONS 14 THROUGH 17 OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT
49 BYLAWS BE VIOLATED, RIGHTS TO GRANTED FUNDING WILL BE
50 FORFEITED AND THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID,
51 UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THE RULES.
