7 **A BILL**

8 **TO AMEND ARTICLE VI, SECTION 16 OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT BY-LAWS.**

9 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, ARTICLE VI, SECTION 16.F OF THE BY-LAWS  
 10 CURRENTLY READS:  
 11 F. Any money expended from the Student Government surplus  
 12 account, Facility Access Fee, Student Government Initiatives or  
 13 Student Government Newspaper Initiatives of Student  
 14 Government shall be approved as follows:  
 15 1. Introduction of a bill as defined in the Student Senate Rules  
 16 of Order Specifying how the money will be spent.  
 17 2. By an affirmative vote of a majority of the Senators present  
 18 and voting at a meeting of the Student Senate.  
 19 3. The President of the Student Government shall then sign or  
 20 veto the bill. The Senate shall have the right to override a  
 21 veto of the President by a 2/3 vote of the senators present  
 22 and voting at a meeting of the student senate.

27 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, FORMER CHANCELLOR EMMERT, IN A MEMO TO  
 28 FORMER STUDENT BODY PRESIDENT McCUNE, AFFIRMED THAT  
 29 FUNDS EXPENDED FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT  
 30 INITIATIVES ACCOUNT SHALL BE AT THE "REQUEST OF THE  
 31 STUDENT GOVERNMENT PRESIDENT AND APPROVAL OF A SIMPLE  
 32 MAJORITY OF THE STUDENT SENATE."; AND

34 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT BY-LAWS  
 35 CURRENTLY CONFLICT WITH A DIRECT MANDATE BY THE  
 36 CHANCELLOR, PREVENTING THE USE OF FUNDS FROM THE  
 37 STUDENT GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES ACCOUNT .

 39 THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT  
 40 GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY  
 41 AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE THAT  
 42 ARTICLE VI, SECTION 16.F OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT BY-  
 43 LAWS WILL NOW READ:  
 44 F. Any money expended from the Student Government surplus  
 45 account, Facility Access Fee, or Student Government Newspaper  
 46 Initiatives of Student Government shall be approved as follows:  
 47 1. Introduction of a bill as defined in the Student Senate Rules  
 48 of Order Specifying how the money will be spent.

- 50 2. By an affirmative vote of a majority of the Senators present  
51 and voting at a meeting of the Student Senate.  
52 3. The President of the Student Government shall then sign or  
53 veto the bill. The Senate shall have the right to override a  
54 veto of the President by a 2/3 vote of the senators present  
55 and voting at a meeting of the student senate.

57 **A SECTION 16.I WILL BE ADDED THAT READS:**

- 58 I. Any money expended from the Student Government Initiatives  
59 account shall be approved as follows:  
60 1. Introduction of an Executive Order by the President  
61 2. An affirmative vote of a majority of the Senators  
62 present and voting at a meeting of the Student Senate.

64 **PARAGRAPH 4:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY  
65 VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE  
66 PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR  
67 IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY  
68 THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
