14 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, EACH SEMESTER CAREER SERVICES HOLDS A
15 "CAREER EXPO" WHERE STUDENTS OF ALL MAJORS ARE INVITED
16 TO MEET REPRESENTATIVES FROM DIFFERENT CORPORATIONS
17 AROUND THE COUNTRY; AND

19 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, LAST SEMESTER OVER 200 DIFFERENT
20 CORPORATIONS WERE REPRESENTED AND COUNTLESS STUDENTS
21 TOOK ADVANTAGE OF THIS INCREDIBLE NETWORKING

24 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, MANY STUDENTS USE THE SPRING CAREER EXPO, IN
