9 **TO APPROPRIATE FIFTEEN THOUSAND (\$15,000.00) DOLLARS FROM THE STUDENT**  
10 **GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES ACCOUNT TO THE CENTER FOR ACADEMIC SUCCESS (CAS)**  
11 **TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF HIRING ADDITIONAL TUTORS**

14 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE CENTER FOR ACADEMIC SUCCESS (CAS) OFFERS  
15 A WIDE RANGE OF PROGRAMS TO MEET THE SPECIALIZED NEEDS  
16 OF STUDENTS; AND

18 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, ONE SUCH PROGRAM IS THE TUTORIAL CENTERS,  
19 WHOSE GOAL IS TO HELP STUDENTS MASTER COURSE CONTENT  
20 AND DEVELOP STUDY STRATEGIES FOR SPECIFIC COURSES; AND

22 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHERAS, CAS EXPERIENCES AN OVERWHELMING INCREASE IN  
23 THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS SEEKING TUTORING DURING MID-  
24 TERMS AND FINALS AND JUST BEFORE THE BEGINNING OF THE  
25 SUMMER SESSIONS, AND

27 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THESE TUTORING SESSIONS ARE AVAILABLE TO ALL  
28 LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENTS **FREE OF COST**, AND

30 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, THIS MONEY SHALL BE USED FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE  
31 OF HIRING ADDITIONAL TUTORS FOR FINALS WEEK AND THE  
32 SUMMER SESSIONS, AND IF ALLOCATED FUNDS SHOULD REMAIN,  
33 USE THESE REMAINING FUNDS FOR THE FOLLOWING MIDTERMS  
34 WEEK.

36 **PARAGRAPH 6:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT  
37 GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY  
38 AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE THAT  
39 FIFTEEN THOUSAND (\$15,000.00) DOLLARS BE APPROPRIATED  
40 FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES ACCOUNT TO  
41 THE CENTER FOR ACADEMIC SUCCESS TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST  
42 OF HIRING ADDITIONAL TUTORS.

44 **PARAGRAPH 7:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY  
45 (1/2 PLUS 1) VOTE OF THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE AND  
46 SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR  
47 PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND  
48 SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF  
49 SUCH APPROVAL.
