8 **TO URGE AND REQUEST THE DEPARTMENT OF STUDENTS' RIGHTS AND WELFARE TO**
9 **CONSTRUCT A WALL SIZE BULLETIN BOARD AND SUGGESTION BOX, TO BE MOUNTED**
10 **OUTSIDE THE LIBRARY WITH THE TITLE "TIGER WALL" ABOVE IT.**

11 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE STUDENT BODY TURNOUT OF ORGANIZATION
12 MEETINGS AND EVENTS HAPPENINGS ON-CAMPUS AND OFF-
13 CAMPUS HAS SEEN A DECREASE IN RECENT YEARS; AND,

14 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE TURNOUT AND RESPONSE FROM BROADCAST E-
15 MAILS HAS BEEN UNSATISFACTORY COMPARED TO THE TOTAL
16 NUMBER OF STUDENTS ENROLLED AT LSU; AND,

17 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE LIBRARY AND QUAD ARE FOCAL POINTS OF
18 PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC ON-CAMPUS; AND,

19 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THERE IS CURRENTLY NO ONE BULLETIN BOARD LARGE
20 ENOUGH TO POST EVERY EVENT AND POSTING THE LSU
21 COMMUNITY WOULD LIKE TO POST; AND,

22 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, A STUDENT'S RIGHT TO FREE SPEECH AND CRITICISM
23 OF STUDENT GOVERNMENT SHOULD BE UPHELD BY HAVING A
24 MORE AVAILABLE MEDIUM FOR TRANSFERRING IDEAS AND
25 COMMENTS; AND,

26 **PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, ONE SIDE IS DESIGNATED FOR FREE SPEECH POSTINGS,
27 WHERE ANYONE CAN POST ANYTHING LESS THAN OFFENSIVE
28 MATERIAL. THE OTHER SIDE WOULD BE RESERVED FOR STUDENT
29 GOVERNMENT TO POST LEGISLATION, OFFICE VACANCY
30 ADVERTISEMENTS, OR ANYTHING STUDENT GOVERNMENT NEEDS
31 TO ALERT THE STUDENT BODY OF; AND,

32 **PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, ACCOMPANYING THIS "TIGER WALL" WILL BE A
33 SUGGESTION BOX LOCATED NEXT TO THE STUDENT
34 GOVERNMENT BULLETIN SIDE SO THAT STUDENTS CAN VOICE
35 THEIR OPINIONS ABOUT LEGISLATION AND LSU MORE EASILY.

36 **PARAGRAPH 8:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT
37 GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY
38 AND AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE TO
39 REQUEST THE DEPARTMENT OF STUDENT RIGHTS
40 AND WELFARE TO CONSTRUCT THE PROPOSED
41 "TIGER WALL" AND SUGGESTION BOX; AND,
